<b>Revised Guidelines for Supplementary Examinations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Theory Courses / Practical Courses / Comprehensive Viva-voce / Project Viva-Voce / Value Education / Soft Skill Courses / Extension (UG &amp; PG).</li> </ul>
<b>Vocational Course</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ A certificate course in the major discipline is mandatory under the vocational stream to all I UG students.</li> <li>◆ A diploma course in the major discipline has mandatory under the vocational stream to all II UG students.</li> <li>◆ Exemption can be given to the students of I UG &amp; II UG enrolled in the following courses of performing arts with a maximum strength of 120 for I UG and 40 for II UG.</li> </ul>
<b>Special area study paper</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ M.Phil scholars who have passed in the Special area study paper are only eligible to submit the dissertation.</li> <li>◆ After submission of dissertation, viva – voce will be conducted only to those scholars who have passed in all three papers offered in Semester I.</li> </ul>
<b>Provisions for differently-abled students (UG, PG &amp; M. Phil.)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Suggested to bring in next meeting with revision.</li> </ul>
<b>Virtual Courses</b>	Each department suggested to offer compulsorily one virtual course in their UG/PG programme with stipulated guidelines.
