## 1. Evolving norms to collect breakage fee for all science courses

## Minutes of the meeting held on 07.09.13

#### Norms for Laboratory Breakage Fees

#### For Physics, Chemistry & Biochemistry departments

- For individual breakage
  - Actual cost of apparatus + 10% is to be collected as breakage fees.
  - If the broken apparatus is newly bought during the Academic year, actual cost of apparatus will be collected.

#### • For general breakage

- $\checkmark$  The following amount to be distributed among the students using the lab.
  - Usage of instruments 10% of actual cost to be paid by individual students divided equally.
  - Damages, items broken during handling, cleaning, etc
- ✓ The amount collected for the usage of instruments can be utilized for purchasing new instruments for the next academic year.
- ✓ Breakage amount to be collected after ESE practical / before issuing the Hall ticket.

#### For CS & CA departments

- The breakage amount is to be collected depending on the usage of the lab hours.
- The following is the number of hour's usage and the amount to be collected from students.

- Rs. 50 is collected extra for the course Digital for I Computer Science students alone for the usage of Digital Lab.

# Norms for conducting remedial coaching for the courses less pass percentage

# Purpose:

- ✓ To motivate the students to understand a subject, rather than feeling pressured to learn everything immediately.
- $\checkmark$  To make the students to clear all the papers.

# I. Identifying the courses:

- ✓ Only allied Maths offered to Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science and Computer Application.
- ✓ Major & Allied Chemistry

# II. Identifying the students:

- ✓ Remedial coaching can be given for slow learners in each course offered by chemistry and mathematics department by identifying the students those who secured below 40% in Entry behavior test and CIA test I for I year students.
- ✓ End semester Examination, CIA and classroom performance for II and III year students.

- III. Course-in-charge as suggested by HoD.
- IV. Monitoring concerned Department Heads

#### Remedial Measure:

#### I. Time and Period

 ✓ Special class can be conducted outside the class hours Outside the class hours:

Time: 4.30pm – 5.30pm

- Test in Hostel for the students residing in hostel
   1 week prior to CIA test I & II.
   10 days before the End Semester Examination
- ✓ Study material, question banks and unsolved question papers of the previous years are provided and repeated tests can be conducted regularly to improve and assess performance.

#### Note:

- $\checkmark$  Schedule to be prepared by the course in charge in consultation with HoD.
- ✓ Course teacher is responsible for conducting regular remedial class.

#### **Guidelines for PG project**

#### On campus

- The Guide to engage the students during the project hour to make it more effective.
- The Faculty to make themselves free in the project hour. So the project hour to be incorporated in such a way in the time table.
- The Guide
  - To obtain a weekly plan and report from the students and to file it regularly.
  - To maintain a separate attendance for their project hour.
  - To submit the weekly report to the Director.

#### **Guidelines:**

• The project hours can be incorporated in the time table as follows I hr of the week - Guide hour

II hr	- Library hour
III & IV hr	- Field work/ Library hour

Note : In case all Faculty in the department are acting as a guide, they can exchange the first two hours of the week with the prior approval of the Director.

#### **Off Campus**

- The students to submit the weekly schedule of their field work to their respective guides in advance and to submit the report of the same immediately after the field visit.
- Supporting evidence of the field work to be submitted along with the weekly report.

#### Eligibility

- Final UG students are eligible to appear for Viva.
- Students should have paid all fees (term fees, exam fees, vocational fees)
- Minimum required attendance for even semester is 75%. In case of 65 74% attendance, the students can appear for Viva on payment of condonation fee of `.375/-

#### Assessment

The marks to be allotted by the External Examiner as per the following criteria

Understanding	-	10 marks
Response to questions	-	10 marks
Communication skill	-	5 marks
Total		25 marks

#### Guidelines

#### HoD

- Submission of three choices of External examiners to COE office.
- HoD to depute Class teacher to accompany the examiner during Viva.
- HoD to monitor the alternate class arrangement done by Class teacher

#### **Class teacher**

- The class-in-charge is responsible for submitting
- Evaluation form,
- Student attendance sheet,
- Claim form
- Feedback form of the external examiner to Examination office on the same day.

#### General

- The questions will be from the subjects of all semesters.
- The viva to be conducted by the External examiner.
- A minimum of 2 questions to be asked from any five subjects (Choice of the students).

- Total -10 questions.
- Duration of Viva for a student is 15 mins.
- 20 students for a session
