#### 3. Guidelines for II UG seminar & III UG journal club

#### a) Before Presentation:

- Schedule to be prepared in the prescribed format circulated by Dean (A) office.
- Recent topics to be given for seminar in their respective discipline.
- For JC topics to be given from the current journal in their respective discipline.
- Signature to be obtained from the students in the schedule.
- Schedule to be pasted in the department notice board & Class room.
- Presentation to be done in PPT.
- Teacher in charge has to guide/ orient the students before presentation.
- Approval to be obtained from the HoD in the hard copy of the student's presentation by the Teacher in charge one week prior.
- Students have to come with full preparation on the day of seminar or jc.

#### b) On the day of presentation:

- Minimum 30 minutes to be provided for each student.
- Separate register to be maintained to record the marks.
- Allotment of marks for seminar content (3m), presentation (3m), Com. skill (2m), Q & A (2).
- Allotment of marks for JC- Contemporary topic(1m), content(2), clarity in explanation (2m), Com.skill (2m), Q & A (3).
- After presentation & allotment of marks, signature to be obtained from the students & HoD.
- Students should not take leave on the day of presentation.

#### c) After presentation:

- Soft & Hard copy of the presentation to be maintained by the course teacher.
- At end of each semester signature to be obtained from Dean A in the consolidated mark statement and maintain in the department.

#### **ESE - Practical Guidelines**

# **Preparation for the Practical Exam by Students:**

- Students to have completed all the experiments.
- Entered all the procedures and calculations both in observation & record and got it corrected from the course-in-charge faculty.
- Should have got the HOD's Signature in the record.

- Paid the term fee and exam fee and breakage amount wherever applicable.
- Component completion to be ensured.

#### Preparation for the Practical Exam by the department.

- All the solutions / apparatus and system to be made ready the previous day.
- Answer script, attendance sheet foil sheet, envelop and remuneration forms to be obtained from Exam Office on the previous day.
- Lot number to be marked in the allotted places / Question Papers.

#### **During Examination:**

- Question paper to be prepared along with key by internal and external examiners and question paper printouts / taken Xerox before the start of examination (09.15 a.m. / 01.15 p.m.).
- Records to be submitted before commencement of Practical Examination.
- Internal, skilled and Lab assistants to be present at 09.00 a.m.
- Students to be seated according to lots allotted / attendance order.
- Unnecessary stationary and pouches to be strictly prohibited.
- Silence to be maintained and attendance form to be signed by the students in the first 30 minutes of the examination by skilled Assistant.
- The procedure writing time is to be provided (10 20 minutes) and the papers are to be collected before the commencement of the experiment.
- The experiment and calculations are to be submitted before leaving the Lab and no paper (blank sheets / rough work) is allowed to be carried out of the lab.
- Viva is to be conducted individually, both by internal and external members.
- Answer scripts are to be corrected both by internal and external members as per key.
- Other staff members prohibited in the Exam Hall strictly.

#### Documents to be submitted in the Exam Office:

- Mark sheet, valued answer scripts, question paper, attendance sheet and claim form duly signed by internal and external members are to submitted at the end of the Practical examination to the Exam Office.
- Minutes of the examination to be entered in the minutes note at the end of each exam.

# C. PASSING MINIMUM FOR ESE (with effect from 2016-2017)

- Passing minimum for UG course is 40% in ESE and 40% in the aggregate of CIA and ESE.
- Passing minimum for PG course is 50% of marks inn ESE and 50% in the aggregate of CIA and ESE.

# D. Revised Guidelines for Supplementary Examinations (with effect from-November 2015) Theory Courses/ Practical courses/ Comprehensive Viva-voce/ Project Viva-voce / Value Education/ Soft Skill Courses/ Extension (UG & PG).

# **ESE-November:**

• Students with arrear/absent in theory/ practical/ theory cum practical/ project courses of Semesters I, III &V are eligible to appear in ESE-November.

# ESE-April:

- Students with arrear/absent in theory/ practical/theory cum practical/project / Comprehensive viva voce courses of semesters II,IV & VI are eligible to appear in ESE-April.
- Final year students with arrear/absent in courses of semester V of UG MCA, Courses of Semester III of PG and courses of Semester I of M.Phil are eligible to appear in ESE-April along with final semester Examination.

# June Supplementary Examinations (Theory):

• Final year students who have only one arrear in the courses of I-VI semesters of UG, I-IV semesters of PG, I-VI semester of MCA and I Semester of M.Phil are eligible to appear for June supplementary examinations.

# **Extension activity:**

• If a student is Not completed (NC) due to the lack of attendance, she has to redo the course along with the next batch after the payment of registration fee Rs.250.

# E. M.Phil- special area paper:

- M.Phil scholars who have passed in the special area study paper are only eligible submit the dissertation
- After submission of dissertation, viva-voce will be conducted only to those scholars who have passed in all three papers offered in Semester I.

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
