




College Profile

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Under Graduate Courses

Candidates seeking admission to the first year of the Bachelor Degree shall be required to have passed higher secondary examination conducted by the Government of Tamilnadu or an examination accepted as equivalent.

The upper age limit for admission in UG courses will be 21 years as on 1st July of the year of admission, however a relaxation upto 5 years is permitted for physically challenged.

Post Graduate Courses

For admission to PG, a candidate must have passed the 3 years degree courses (under 10+2+3 pattern) Recognized by the University as equivalent thereto. For courses other than MCA, the qualifying examination marks in part III (Major, Allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

For MCA admission, AICTE/TANCET Anna University norms will have to be followed.

M. Phil

Candidates seeking admission to research programme shall be required to have completed their relevant Post Graduate degree.

Ph. D

A candidate should have obtained a Master's Degree with not less than a second class or an equivalent grade.


D.Angalaparameswari II B.A. English represented our college in seven days National Integration Camp held at Agriculture University, Bangalore.




