



UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

Candidates seeking admission to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree must have passed higher secondary examination conducted by the government of Tamilnadu or an examination accepted as equivalent.

The upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 years as on 1st July of the year of admission. However a relaxation upto 5 years for the physically challenged and 3 years for women candidates is permitted.

POST GRADUATE COURSES

For admission to PG, the candidate must have passed a 3 year degree course (under 10+2+3 pattern). For courses other than MCA, the qualifying examination marks in part III (major, allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

For admission to MCA, AICTE/TANCET Anna University norms will be followed.

Candidates seeking admission to research programmes must have completed their relevant post graduate degree with minimum 55% of marks.

Ph.D.

The candidate should have obtained a master's degree with not less than a second class or an equivalent grade.











