



#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

#### Under Graduate Courses

Candidate seeking admission to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree must have passed higher secondary examination (+2) conducted by the Government of Tamilnadu or an examination accepted as equivalent.

The Upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 years as on 1st July of the year of admission. However and 3 years for women candidates is permitted.

#### Post Graduate Courses

For admission to PG, the candidate must have passed a 3 year Degree course (under 10+2+3 pattern). For courses other than MCA the qualifying examination marks in part III (major, allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

For admission to MCA, AICTE/TANCET Anna University norms will be followed.

#### M.Phil.

Candidates seeking admission to research programmes must have completed their relevant Post Graduate Degree with minimum 55% of marks and 5% mark relaxation to SC/ST Candidate.

The Candidate should have obtained a Master's Degree with not less than a second class or an equivalent grade.

#### How To Apply

- Cost of application form is ₹350/-
- · Application forms can be downloaded from the website www.tacw.in. At the time of registration, ₹350/- has to be paid in cash or by Demand Draft (DD) drawn in favour of The Secretary, Theivanai Ammal College for Women payable at Villupuram.

Last date for the receipt of application form will be 10 working days after the issue of HSC/ Qualifying exam Marks Statement


