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CURRICULAR ASPECTS

In accordance to UGC guidelines and National Education Policy 2020, our College has implemented learning outcome Based Curriculum(LOCF) 2021- 2024 batch onwards. In addition to that POs, PSOs, Cos and LOs have been formulated for all the programs offered by our college and department in accordance to the quality policy, vision, mission and goals. The course profiles are designed to render contemporary knowledge and skills for empowering rural women. To achieve its PO, PSO and CO through various parts of the curriculum such as Critical thinking, Effective communication, Ethics and effective citizenship, self directed and lifelong learners are established.

Faculties are enriched with number of Professional Development Programmes before designing the curriculum adhering the guidelines of UGC, TANSCHER every year during the syllabus revision. Thus competency based curriculum is designed.

Provision in the curriculum are as follows:

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course enhances the Tamil/French/Hindi and English Language proficiency in two levels as basic and advanced according to the interest of the students.

SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES (SEC)

In SEC, students are benefited by taking other discipline course for enriching their professional knowledge to serve in the society. Application oriented papers are offered under Generic Elective to upgrade the interdisciplinary skills. Recent trend papers are offered under Discipline specific Elective with choice to promote students interest in Research. Value oriented courses are offered to inculcate moral, ethical and social needs of the students. To enhance the employability Skill, Soft Skill courses are provided such as Professional Skill, Interpersonal Skill and Career skill.

NPTEL (MOOCS)/Spoken Tutorial (FOOS)

Knowledge transformation using ICT as educational tool has made significant improvement by incorporating MOOCs & FOSS were made mandatory within the curriculum In collaboration with NPTEL, IIT Chennai & Spoken tutorial, IIT Bombay our college has established nodal center. These platforms immensely benefitted 665 students and Faculty.

STATUTORY BODIES

As per UGC Norms Under academic autonomy the college has formed various Statutory Committees. The Governing Body of the college guides the policy making. Academic Council meeting satisfies the syllabi approved by the board of studies of the respective departments.

TEACHING & LEARNING

The IQAC is continuously monitoring, evaluating and reporting on the quality of Teaching Methods used, classroom environment and the effect on student performance. Teaching and learning schedule are routinely prepared and implemented to facilitate teaching learning process.



•ICT ENABLED LEARNING METHODS are adopted to enhance the learning environment and to create autonomous learner in ICT class rooms provided with LCD projector, screen & internet.

- Online Teaching is conducted efficiently through Microsoft Teams utilizing more tools in a class. Conducting Online Meeting for the Faculty and Viva-Voce to the students. Flexibilities available to the students to record the class and download for off-line.
- Virtual Lab – college is collaborated with Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Kerala to avail the various tools for learning, including additional web-resources, video-lectures, animated demonstrations and self evaluation at the undergraduate level and post graduate level.

Online Courses allows individualistic learning with choice of in selection of courses. Irrespective of their discipline incorporated in the curriculum. The NPTEL / SPOKEN TUTORIAL courses offered to the UG/PG students under the category of extra credit earning provision. **548 Students** have completed the online Course in NPTEL / SPOKEN TUTORIAL and **83 students** were registered the online course in NPTEL / SPOKEN TUTORIAL.

Internship/ Field Work/ Field Projects for UG/PG students for **30 hours**. It allows hands on experience and students to gain practical knowledge from the industry/fields under the category of extra credit earning provision. **721 Students** have completed the internship and **328 students** has been attending the internship

e-CONTENT

Examination during Pandemic

The paradigm shift was to host the data in cloud-based servers to have completed access from anywhere and as a consequence, to be able to carry out routine work like data entry and declaration of results remotely. This was of immense help to college during the pandemic period for the conduct of online examinations and declaration of timely results in spite of lockdown restrictions. The Examination cell ensured quality proctoring of online examinations during the pandemic through safe-browsers provided by **Mastersoft ERP through CIMS portal and Microsoft Teams App**.

- ▶ Offline examinations were conducted with the question paper prepared by the external experts and practical and projects are assessed by external examiners.
- ▶ Online payment of examination fee through feepayr.com.
- ▶ Sending CIA & ESE time table notification to the students through whats app group.
- ▶ Publication of End Semester Examination results in college website & students app within 7days (Nov.2021).

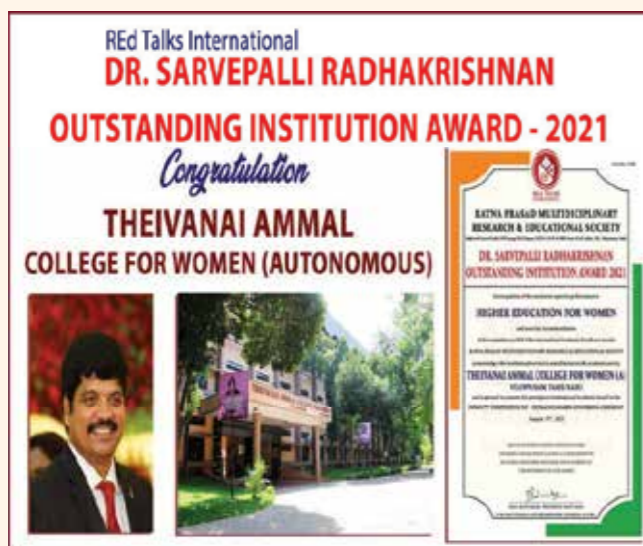

HAPTIC TECHNOLOGY IN CURRENT SCENARIO

In India, Computer Science is a booming sector. Technology is advancing day by day at a rapid pace, so, “Never stop Learning”. Continuously update your skills to meet competitiveness. Diversity, Relevance, and expertise are the keys to success in this fast-changing world.

Haptic Technology is a touch sensation and control to interact with computer applications as like exploring the virtual world. The computer communicates sensations through a haptic interface– a stick, scalpel, racket, or pen that is connected to a force-exerting motor.

“As technology evolves and computer power grows, Haptic devices and effects evolve and get more realistic”

HAPTIC SHOES FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED

A Haptic shoe that receives signals from GPS-enabled smart phones or smart watches allows the blind and visually impaired to walk independently, giving directions and alerting to obstacles. The idea of conveying directional information in a non-obtrusive and non-distracting manner, using haptic technology, seemed very helpful. Shoes were selected as an ideal medium because they are the most natural extension of the human body, and shoes always point in the direction a person intends to walk.

It consists of actuators and vibrators located in the front sides, and back of the shoe. With the help of a proprietary app loaded with GPS-enabled smart phones or smart watches, the user can connect with the shoe via Bluetooth and interact with the app to set a destination. The app has been designed using various accessibility options to enable completely eye-free interface use. Once the destination has been set, the smart phones or smart watches calculate a route and through a series of vibrations guides the user from one point to another. The front of the shoe vibrates to indicate to go forward, the left side to turn left, and so on. The Shoe also includes sensors to detect obstacles such as sidewalks, staircases, and manholes. The user is alerted and guided via a series of vibrations to navigate around the obstacle or to find an alternate route.

The library and information services of the 21st century are fast changing. With the rapid development of electronic publishing, libraries are not only acquiring reading materials such as printed books and journals but also arranging for providing access to various learning resources in electronic form. The web resources and the use of web as a tool is changing the way users live and learn. Library Services with electronic resources provides access to a huge range of support in studies, research and teaching. An electronic resource is any information source that the library provides access to in an electronic format. The web resources and the use of web as a tool is changing the way users live and learn. While in the early phase, the World Wide Web was mainly used for push type applications to provide information and resources to users, the development of Web 2.0 and the spread of open sources and shared use concept have focused on user generated content and applications for sharing. This has led to the rapid development and popularity of electronic resources. E-Resources are occupying a significant portion of the global literature..

E-Resources: E- resources is distribution of information in any electronic form such as CD-ROM, Floppy Disk or Magnetic tape or across a computer network like e-journals, E-Books, ETD etc. accessible dial-up bulletin board or on-line services. Electronic resources consist of data (information representing numbers, text, graphics, images, maps, moving images, music, sounds, etc.), programs (instructions, etc., that process the data for use), or combinations of data and programs. Electronic resources often include components with characteristics found in multiple classes of materials. The Library collects many different types of electronic or non-print items, and provides access to more of this content via subscriptions.

The E-Library includes:

- Electronic versions of documents issued by FERC from 1989 to present
- Documents received and issued by FERC
- A description/index of documents from 1981 to present
- Microfilm of documents for 1981 to 1995
- Images of paper documents for the period 1995 to present
- Native files electronically submitted from November 2000 to present

E-Learning: E-Learning is learning utilizing electronic technologies to access educational curriculum outside of a traditional classroom. In most cases, it refers to a course, program or degree delivered completely online.

ACQUIRING ADEQUATE KNOWLEDGE, SPECIALISED SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT THROUGH NEW VISTAS IN COMMERCE EDUCATION

Realizing the growing demand for human resource in various business sectors, Higher Education Institutions are offering the sector-specific Commerce Degree Courses such as B.Com. (International Accounting and Taxation), B.Com. (Computer Application), B.Com. (Banking and Insurance), B.Com. (E-Commerce), B.Com. (TCS), B.Com. (Auditing), B.Com. (International Business), and B.Com. (Corporate Secretaryship) and the like. The new vistas in commerce education develop the required knowledge, skills and attitudes for the handling of Trade, Commerce and Industry.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT THROUGH COMMERCE EDUCATION

Discipline Specific Core skills developed through commerce education include:

Marketing skills include ability to identify buying behaviour of customers, ability to do critical thinking and problem solving, search engine optimization, social media management, team work, time management and marketing analytics.

(c) Business communication Skill

It includes collaboration skills, negotiation skills, diplomacy skills, written communication, presentation skills, public speaking skills, active listening, delegation skills, non-verbal communication skills, decision making skills and the like. It is the ability to draft business correspondence, banking and insurance correspondence.

(d) Entrepreneurial skill

Entrepreneurial skills are vital for promoting innovation, business growth and competitiveness. It is the capability to commence and manage a business successfully.

(e) Managerial skills

It includes ability to perform functions of management such as planning organizing, staffing, directing, controlling, coordinating, recruiting, training, reporting and budgeting, ability to manage commercial risks, ability to minimise business expenses, ability to maximize profitability to achieve the goals of an organisation, leadership skills and decision making skills.

WHAT MAKES A GOOD RESEARCH PAPER?

Research is a careful consideration of study regarding a particular concern or problem using scientific methods. It involves systematic planning, Procedures, setting time-based and realistic objectives. Replicability, reproducibility and transparency are some of the most important characteristics of research.

A research paper is a type of academic writing that provides an in-depth analysis, evaluation or interpretation of a single topic, based on empirical evidence. Research papers are the most effective ways to share information across a wide network. One of the initial steps you should perform in making a paper stand out is doing a bit of initial exploring to see what is out there already, think about future outline, thesis or hypothesis. After going through the necessary amount of information, data and literature available on your desired topic, it is time to narrow the research down.

To refine your topic and prepare your thesis statement, find out what research is available for your topic as soon as possible. Early research can help dispel any misconceptions you have about the topic and reveal the best paths and approaches to find more material.

Your research paper conclusion should restate your thesis, reiterate your main evidence, and summarize your findings in a way that's easy to understand. Don't add any new information in your conclusion, but feel free to say your own personal perspective or interpretation if it helps the reader understand the big picture. Citing your sources both validates your data and also links your research paper to the greater scientific community.

You should always remember that your research is a solution to the existing problem of society.
