CURRICULAR INNOVATIONS

Outcome-Based Education (OBE) is an educational approach that emphasizes defining desired learning outcomes first and then designing teaching and assessment methods to achieve these outcomes. As Theivanai Ammal College for Women takes pride in empowering women through education, implementing OBE can further enhance the quality and relevance of education, preparing students to meet the challenges of a rapidly changing world.

The learning outcome-based curriculum framework focuses on the expected learning outcomes and academic standards that the graduates of a program of study should achieve. It includes several key outcomes that guide curriculum planning and development at the graduate level. These outcomes are Graduate Attributes, Qualification Descriptors, Programme Learning Outcomes and Course Learning Outcomes. Three new programmes were introduced such as Journalism and Mass Communication, Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics and Costume Design and Fashion.

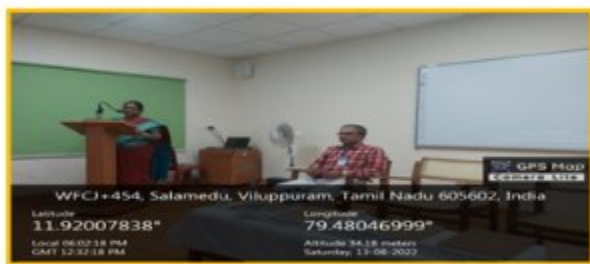
Examination Highlights

PHP scripts from the past,

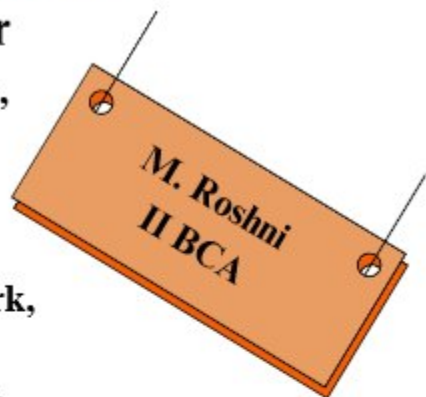
Bits and bytes, a digital blast.

Where wisdom thrives and futures grace.

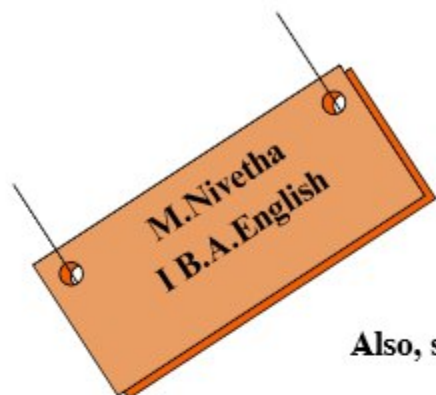

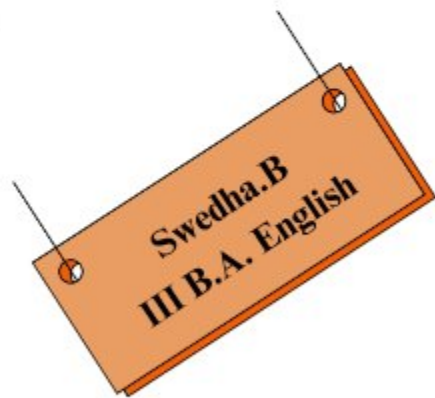


My UNEXPECTED BOOK

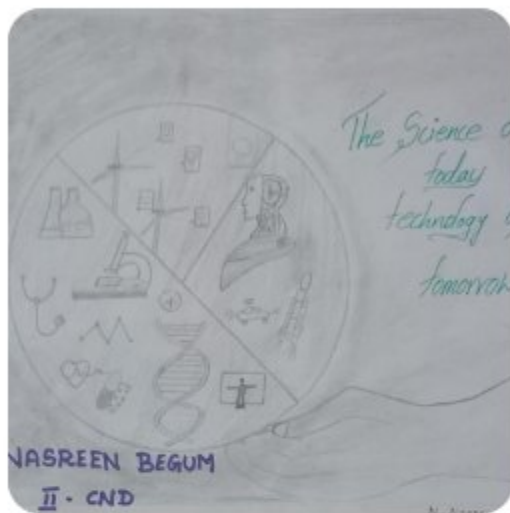
