



1. Subject Knowledge .



2. Interest generated by the teacher towards the subject . 1,230 responses












6. Interaction with students in the class 1,230 responses





7. Syllabus coverage in the question paper 1,230 responses






9.III and IV evaluation components allotted 1,230 responses














7. How do you rate the credit assigned for the Course 102 responses




8. How do you rate the learning levels 102 responses

of the students






9. Able to conduct remedial classes to improve the course outcome Attainment. 102 responses






5. Whether the skill/ job oriented courses is useful for your career 128 responses


















Communication Skill of the candidate














