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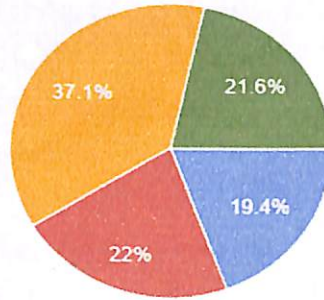

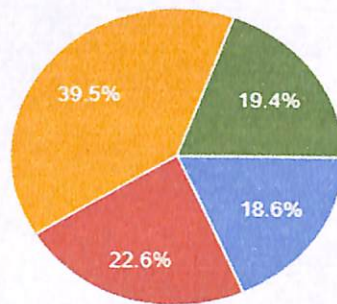

2. Interest generated by the teacher towards the subject

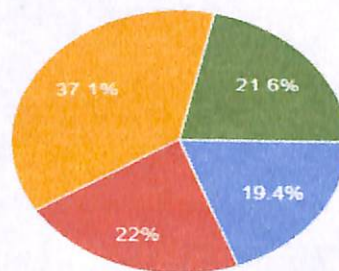

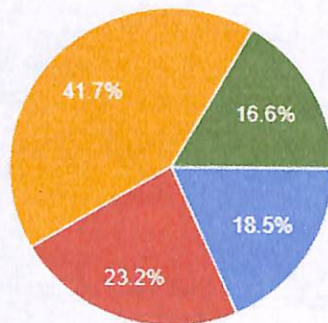

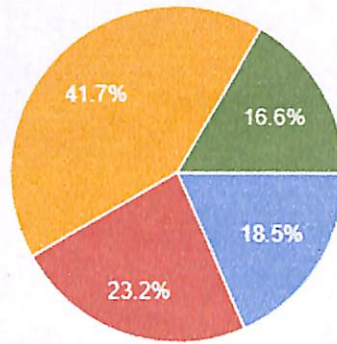


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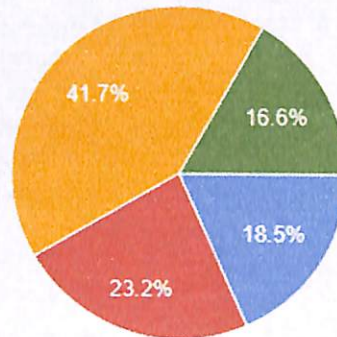
7. Syllabus coverage in the question paper

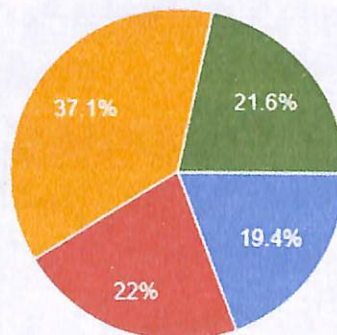

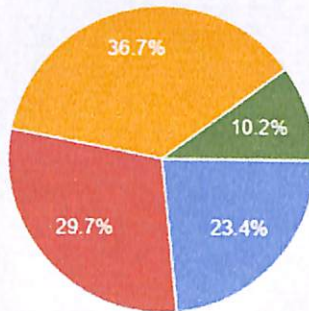

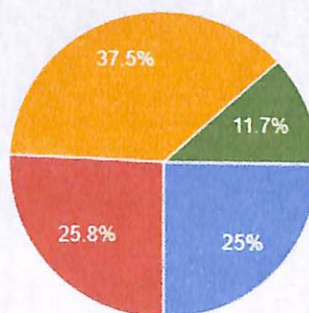

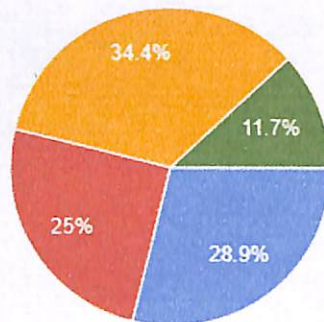

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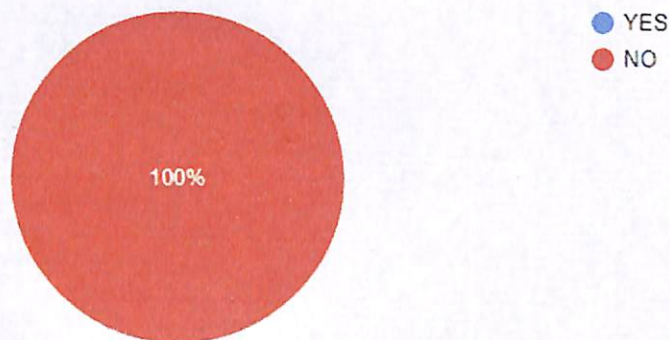
